

COUNTY COORDINATORS RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Make oneself known as a North Carolina Bluebird Society County Coordinator for your respective County.
2. Establish contact with local newspapers to enable an article regarding blue birding in their newspaper during January or February. Include your name, e-mail address and telephone number. (Sample articles are provided in the County Coordinator notebook which will be provided to you.)
3. Serve as a local contact for the North Carolina Bluebird Society providing information and assistance to anyone requesting help.
4. Make use of the NCBS Website www.ncbluebird.org.
5. A listing of other possible County Coordinator activities is provided in the Coordinator notebook, but we want you to do only those activities you feel comfortable with.
6. You will be the local representative of the NCBS. Should you need help or advice, please feel free to consult with another area County Coordinator, your Area Coordinator or Area Co-chairperson.
7. Be a member in good standing of the NCBS.
8. Make reasonable effort to attend the Annual NCBS Annual meeting.
